## *Transfer Guide for Penn State York / Harrisburg Area Community College*

Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) and Penn State York (PSY) have established this transfer guide so that students have a clear idea about the course work that they should complete in order to best transfer into a Bachelor's Degree in Business at Penn State York.

### Recommendations/Notes:

#### Admission Requirements BEFORE transferring to PSY:

1. HACC students generally complete most of their first two years of college. A minimum of 18 credits **attempted** are required to be considered for transfer.
2. Students are required to have a minimum **cumulative** grade point average of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale). GPA's are recalculated to include all courses and grades, including all repeated courses, from all colleges/universities previously attended.
3. Completion of Math 110 @ HACC will meet entrance to major requirements for the BS in Business at PSU. Students are advised to complete Math 110 at HACC prior to transferring to PSU.

1. Penn State requires two units in a single world language other than English. A student may be admitted with fewer than two units in a world language other than English, but must correct this deficiency by the time the student earns 60 credits or graduates from Penn State, whichever comes first. This deficiency may be corrected by passing one three- or four-credit college level world language course or by demonstrating proficiency equivalent to two units of high school world language study.
2. Penn State requires three credits of International Cultures (IL) and three credits of United States Cultures (US). The two courses that fulfill the IL and US requirements can also be used to fulfill the General Education Arts, Humanities or Social Science requirements.
3. The accelerated BSB (Bachelor of Science in Business) program is another option for adult/transfer students.

Please note that articulation agreements are subject to periodic and/or annual updates, and may be revised without notice.

**NOTE: This transfer guide is effective beginning with the FALL 2017 semester. Students transferring prior to FALL 2017 should consult w/ PSY Admissions for the most up-to-date information.**
