Transfer Guide for Penn State York / Harrisburg Area Community College

Harrisburg Area Community College (HACC) and Penn State York (PSY) have established this transfer guide so that students have a clear idea about the course work that they should complete in order to best transfer into a Bachelor's Degree in Psychology at Penn State York.

Admission Requirements:

1. Before transferring, HACC students generally complete most of their first two years of college. A minimum of 18 credits *attempted* are required to be considered for transfer.
2. Students are required to have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale). GPA's are recalculated to include all courses and grades, including all repeated courses, from all colleges/universities previously attended.
3. Students are required to have completed MATH 103 at HACC or 2 years of algebra and 1 year of geometry from high school **before** transferring to PSY.

NOTE: This transfer guide is effective beginning with the FALL 2017 semester. Students transferring prior to FALL 2017 should consult w/ PSY Admissions for the most up-to-date information.

Recommendations/Notes:

1. Although not required for transfer admission, students who graduated from high school in 2001 or later and have not completed the required two high school world language (same language) units must fulfill this high school requirement by completing one semester of a college level world language. This class is considered a high school world language requirement and also counts toward the completion of a baccalaureate degree.
2. Students are strongly advised to complete 3 credits of United States Cultures (US) and 3 credits of International Cultures (IL) within their general education requirements. These courses are listed within the General Education Table below. For this major, only 3 credits of either US or IL are required since an upper division requirement will fulfill either a US or IL equivalent.

The evaluation of all other prior college work is done on an individual basis by the Admissions Office at Penn State York. Students should work closely with their academic adviser at HACC and with Penn State York for the most up-to-date information.

It is recommended students keep copies of any syllabi they are asked to submit to the Undergraduate Admissions Office. This will assist Penn State academic advisers when scheduling courses.

Please note that articulation agreements are subject to periodic and/or annual updates, and may be revised without notice.
